Cotillions are present in most major cities. **This is the 23rd Season of Boise Cotillion. Over 3,500 Treasure Valley children have participated.** Cotillion is considered by many, to be a part of a child's social education. Boise Cotillion will offer dance instruction and exposure to proper social etiquette, in a fun, age appropriate party atmosphere. Children gain an appreciation of the joy of a variety of music and dance, as well as practice good manners and gracious behavior. Each party/lesson will offer instruction in traditional social dances as well as popular favorites including salsa, swing, tango and others. Partners are arranged, and change often. Each child will have approximately six different partners per night.

Emphasis will be placed on social etiquette and fun. Through instruction and practice, good manners become second nature, children gain confidence and poise because they learn how to handle themselves in a variety of social situations. They have fun with their friends, meet new friends from throughout the city, dance, win prizes and enjoy refreshments, while learning social etiquette that will contribute to future success

Cotillion Attire

Young ladies will wear a semi-formal party dress. Cotillion attire is conservative, no strapless, backless or midriff, and nothing too revealing. **Short white gloves are required for girls** (available usually at Dillard's, or online). Gentlemen will wear a suit or sports coat (blazer and khakis), tie, dark socks, and dress shoes. Theme dress is appropriate for 50's and Western. Cotillion is inclusive and respectful of differences, however the above mentioned attire is required.
